

Breezeline Supports New Hampshire Energy Summit

The U.S. internet provider promotes sustainable energy initiatives in the Granite State

CONCORD, N.H., – September 14, 2023 – <u>Breezeline</u>, the eighth-largest cable provider in the U.S., will sponsor and participate in the annual <u>New Hampshire Energy Summit</u> on Sept. 18 in downtown Concord.

The policy conference, now in its 11th year, brings together industry leaders, end users and policy makers to promote dialogue, spur innovation and advance sustainable energy initiatives in the region. More than 150 participants are expected to attend the event.

Breezeline representatives will showcase the company's newly retrofitted electric vehicle (EV) bucket truck at the Summit. In July, Breezeline <u>became</u> the first U.S. cable operator to convert an internal combustion engine aerial bucket truck to full electric power.

"Breezeline continues to make progress in our electrification efforts," said Patrick Higgins, director, enterprise risk management and sustainability for Breezeline. "In addition to the EV bucket truck, we've deployed additional Ford E-Transit vehicles, as well as electric-powered sales vehicles, all first steps in Breezeline's commitment to reduce its operational emissions by 65% by 2030 and achieve net zero emissions by 2050."
